The conference takes place annually, in early January over two and a half days with a programme of papers, discussions and debate in an environment of conviviality and networking opportunities.

Some 700 delegates attend and press coverage ensures a known reach of over 4.5 million.

OFC operates three highly successful leadership programmes namely OFC Scholars, Inspire and Breaking Barriers. Taking individuals with a desire to develop their role within the agricultural community and providing skills to enable them to take their next steps.

- The theme of Oxford Farming Conference 2025 is "Facing Change, Finding Opportunity", please tell us in no more than 1000 words about your concept/proposal/research, how it relates to the 2025 theme and why you would like to present it at OFC. Please prepare you answer on a seperate document and upload it to your application form.
